Basis of the Charge (Be specific as to facts, names, addresses, dates, places, etc.)

On March 8, 2017, the governing body of the Chicago Teachers Union, Local No. 1, American Federation of Teachers, AFL-CIO ("CTU"), announced that it was considering authorizing another one-day strike to take place on May 1, 2017. The CTU engaged in a prior unlawful strike on April 1, 2016 which was the subject a prior unfair labor practice charge (case number 2016 CB 0018 C). The Illinois Educational Labor Relations Board issued an order in that case authorizing its General Counsel to seek an injunction that the CTU not "engage in any future strikes prior to completing the process required by Section 13(b) of the Act." The CBE subsequently withdrew that charge. A strike that occurs prior to the completion of all Section 13(b) requirements and that is not regulated by the Illinois Educational Labor Relations Board violates Section 13(b) and Section 14(b)(3) of the Illinois Educational Labor Relations Act, 115 ILCS 5/1.

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
