WHEREAS, Joel Weisman is a member of the Chicago Television Academy's prestigious Silver Circle; and

WHEREAS, Joel Weisman continues to work as a practicing attorney, specializing in media law; and

WHEREAS, Joel Weisman has hosted of WTTW's respected Chicago Week in Review public affairs program for 40 years; and

WHEREAS, Joel Weisman has announced that the January 19 edition of Chicago Week in Review will be his final appearance as host;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the President and the Cook County Board of Commissioners on behalf of the residents of Cook County, recognize and congratulate Joel Weisman on his professional achievements in journalism and the contributions he has made to civic discourse through his work on Chicago Week in Review; and
