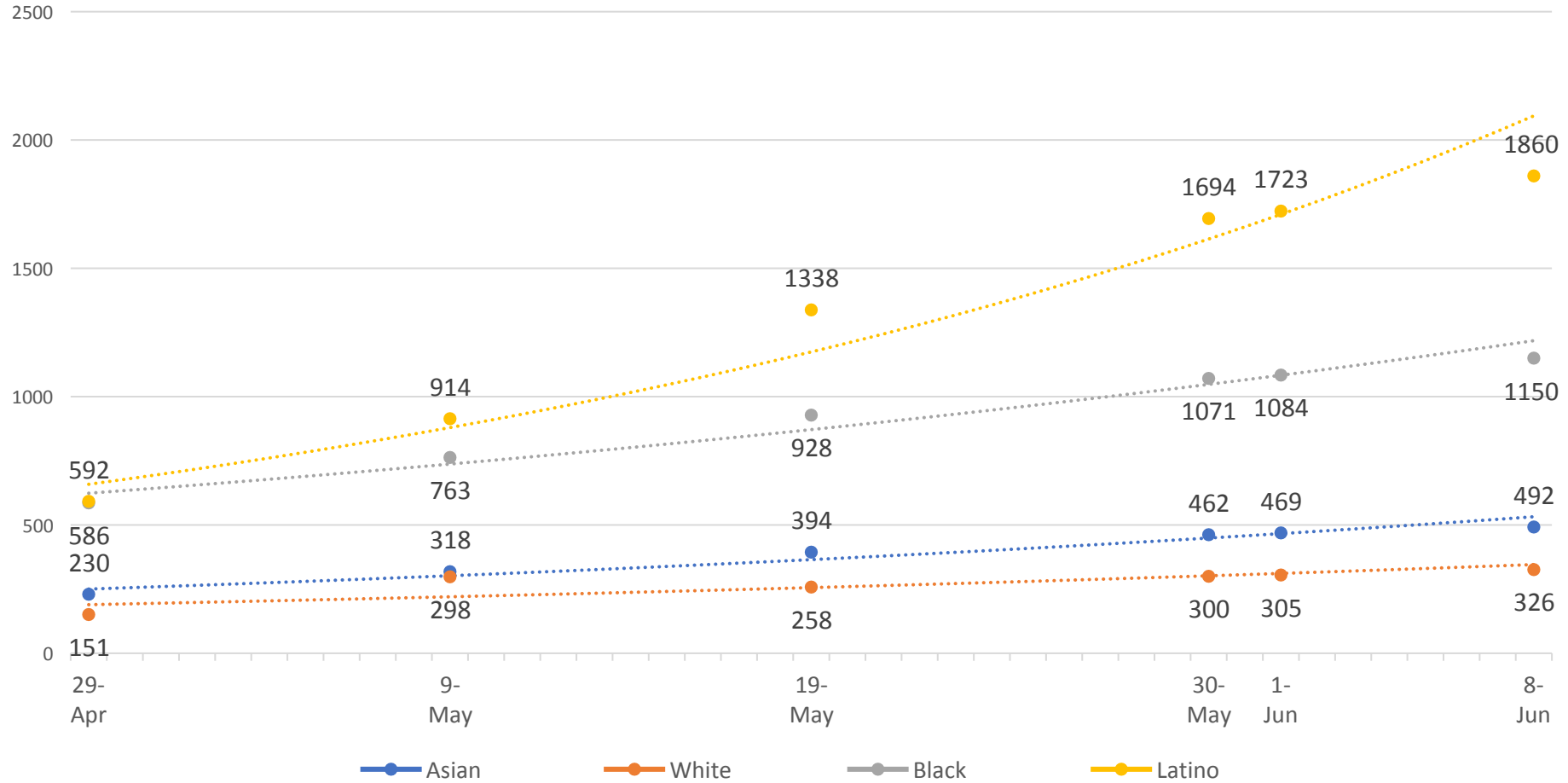
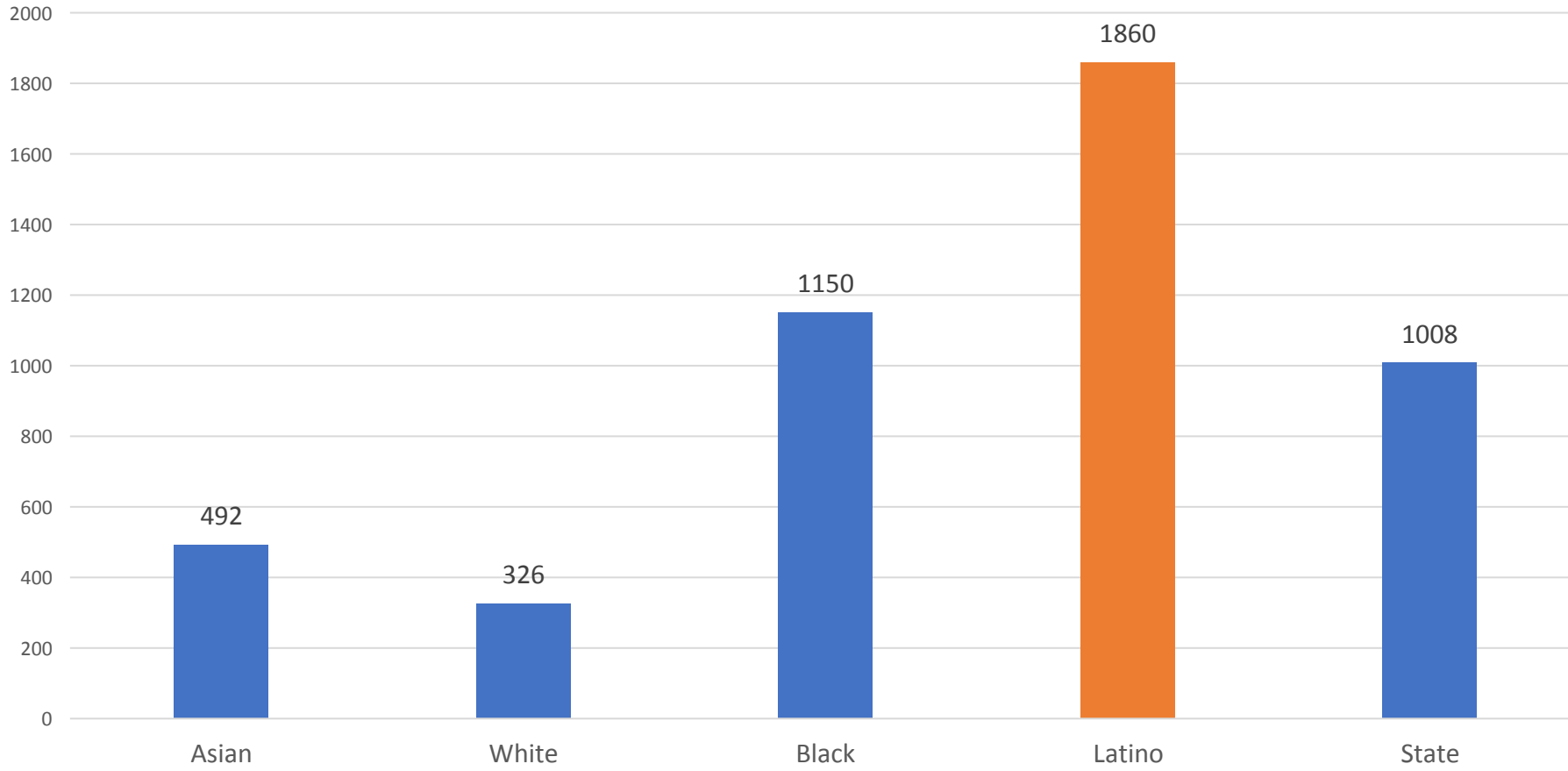


### Cases of COVID-19 per 100,000 Population for Select Races/Ethnicities, Select Dates (April 29 - June 8, 2020), Illinois



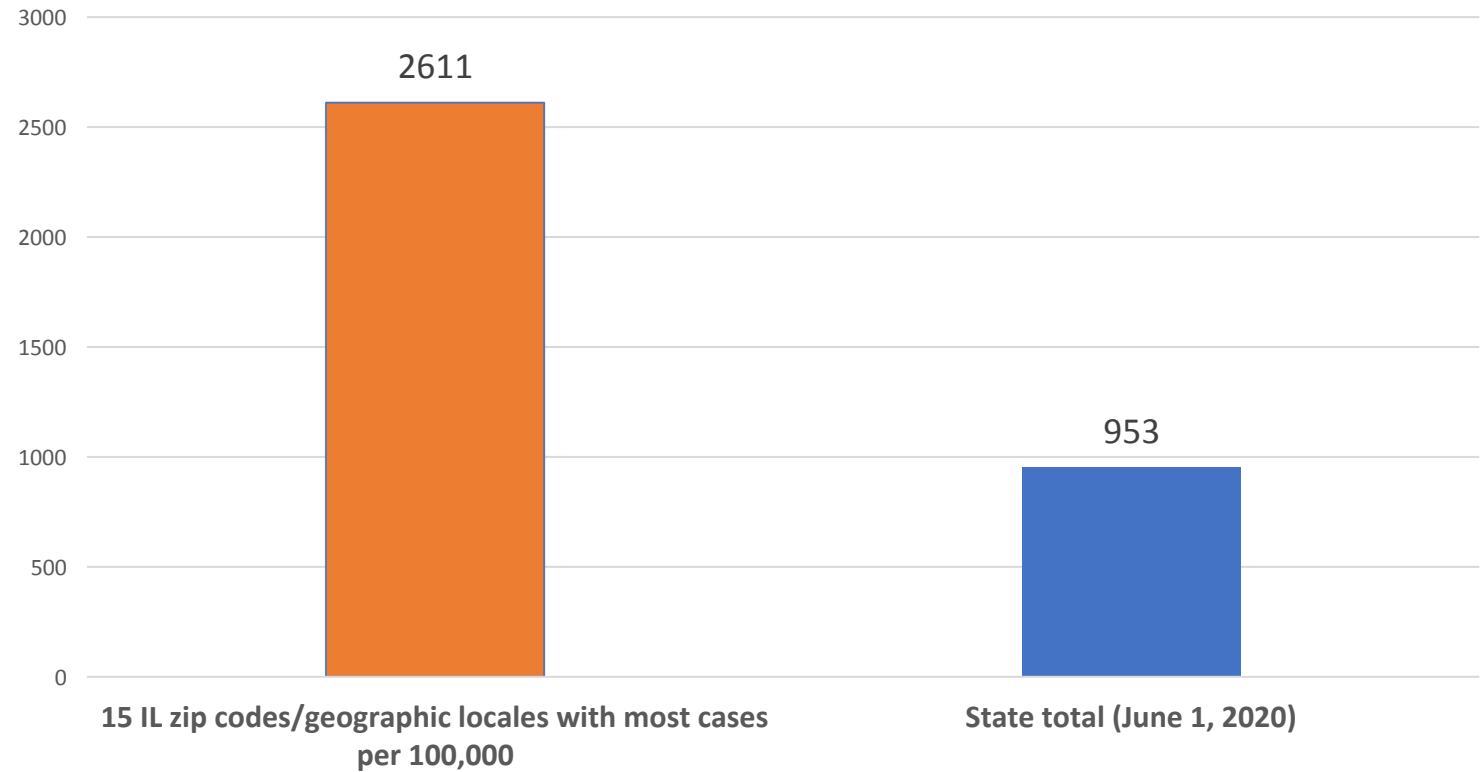

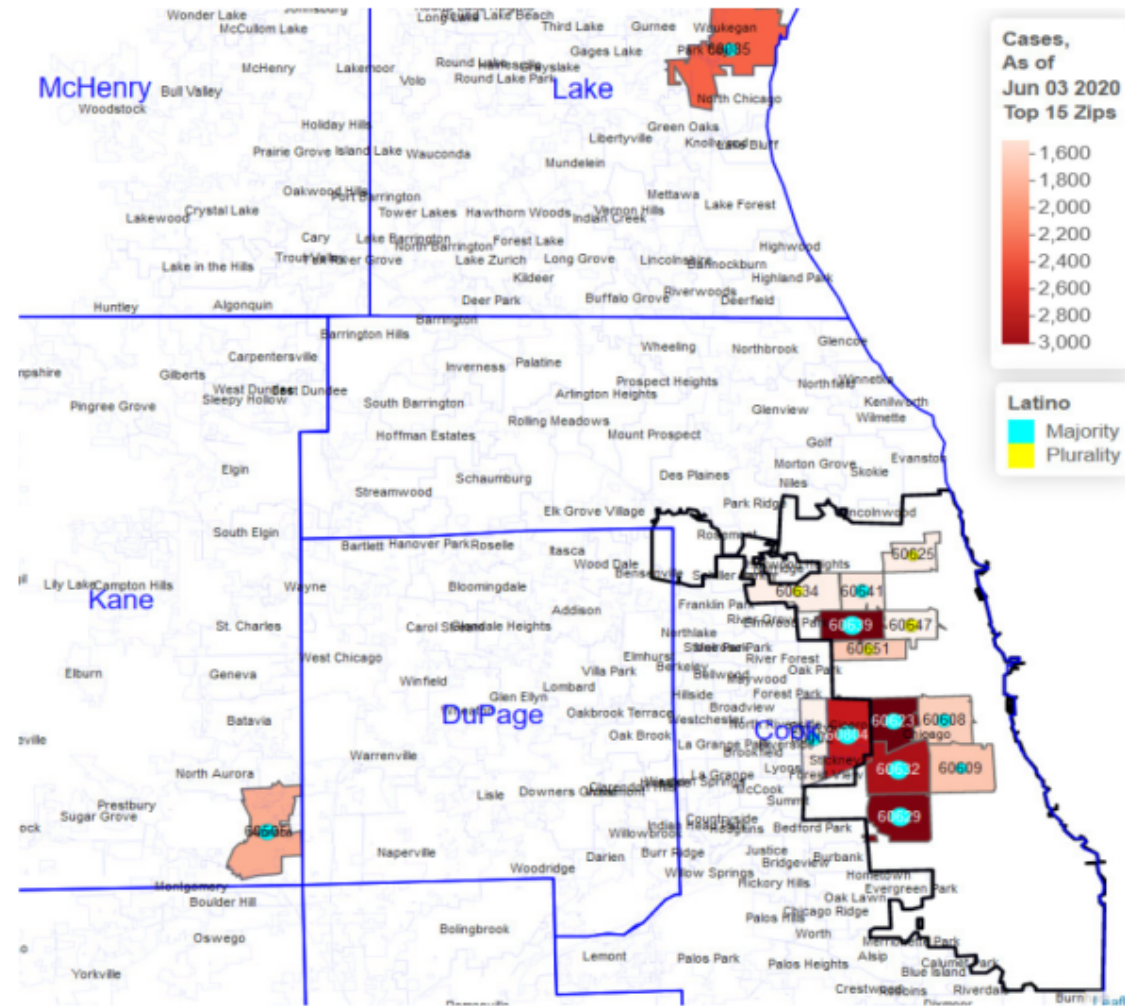
