#### Methodology

This poll was conducted January 28-30, 2018 using both automated (recorded) and live operator-initiated calls cell phones. In all, 811 **likely** Democratic Party voters (**likely** was defined as having voted in at least two of the past three Democratic Primaries) completed all questions on the poll; 400 of the responses came from cell phones. The voters dialed were randomly selected from a proprietary registered-voter database of likely voters to assure the greatest chance of providing an accurate cross-section of opinion from the district-wide sample. Weighting formulas were applied to correct any minor over- and undersampling—no result was changed by more than a 0.4percentage point from that weighting.

Our sampling methodology ensures that *We Ask America* poll results are "projectable," meaning that if *every* resident in a given geography were dialed, the results would not differ from the reported poll results by more than the stated margin of error at a 95% confidence level (the industry standard), if the same survey was repeated. For this case, results with a margin of error of ±3.44% at the 95% confidence level means that if the same survey were conducted 100 times, 95 times out of 100 the results would not vary in either direction by more than 3.44% in either direction.

Properly conducted polls should be considered as snapshots in time—accurate at the time they are conducted, by not necessarily predictive of ultimate outcome.

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
